



5 HITS & 6 RBI FOR NASSAU CO'S PAULSEN

CENTER FIELDER WAS DRIVING FORCE BEHIND HOME SIDE'S DOUBLE-DIGIT WIN OVER ATLANTIC

BROOKLYN (June 27, 1867) – Atlantic BBC & Nassau County entered their tilt at the Long Island Base Ball Grounds a game apart in the standings, but both exited 18-24 (10 GB) thanks to a big Nassau Co. home victory:

Paulsen, in his sixth year as a member of Nassau Co., has been struggling in his first season as a member of the senior squad, batting just .191 with 12 RBI in 39 starts at CF before Thursday's outburst. This could be the start of better things for the 25-year-old.
